The aim of the **Fairground Heritage Trust** is to preserve historic fairground equipment, imagery and memorabilia for future generations, in the hope of fostering understanding of, and support for, a genuinely national institution.

As a vital ingredient in the genesis of leisure in this country, the Fairground Heritage Trust believes that fairground has played just as important a role as any other type of popular entertainment in shaping today's society. Your contribution to the Walk of Fame will enable the Trust to continue this work and will therefore be most appreciated by the Curator and Trustees.

As part of our expansion of **Dingles Fairground Heritage Centre**, we are intending to expand the displays in the original buildings and build several new features and walkways. We need your help to achieve this and are inviting you to become a part of the Museum's fabric.

For a donation of as little as £50 you can have your name or a message carved into a brick that will be built into the museum.

There are two sizes of bricks available: the smallest at 210x105mm (8"x4") takes up to two lines of 16 characters. The larger size is 210x210mm (8" x 8") and can have up to four lines of 16 characters and is especially useful for businesses or for that longer personal message.

Each brick is engraved to a standard depth with your selected message and you have the choice of either Gold or Black lettering.

Your donation is investing in the future of the Fairground Heritage Trust's work and at the same time, recording a timeless memorial for you, your family, your business or friends; one that will be seen by thousands of visitors every year. Businesses may also wish to use this facility as a low-cost way of sponsoring The Trust, obtaining tax advantages and gaining exposure to a large audience at the same time. We also have the facility to embed your company logo in a bespoke brick if required.

This unique and fun way to support the Trust can be available to you, by filling out the application form overleaf and returning to the Trust. You will receive an acknowledgement, receipt and an estimate as to when your brick will be on display in the museum.



Your donation will be used by the Trust to conserve the National Collection of Fairground Rides and Ephemera, to expand the existing Museum displays and to add new items to the collection in line with the Trust's acquisition policy.
